## St. Paul May 'Go West of Missouri.

SIOUX CITY, Iowa, Feb. 10.—The decision of the Sioux Falls and Pacific, said to be an auxiliary of the Chicago, Milwaukee and St. Paul, to build a high bridge over the Missouri River at Chamberlain, S. D., is taken to indicate that the St. Paul Road will terminate its agreement with the Chicago and Northwestern not to build west of the Missouri and extend its lines into the Black Hills. The extension would run through a fine cattle country, and the Northwestern would be compelled in self-defense to build into the hills from Pierre, S. D.
