
J. N. BARR'S NEW POSITION.

Appointed Superintendent of the Chicago, Milwaukee and St. Paul Railroad.

CHICAGO, May 15.—Official announcement was made to-day of the appointment of J. N. Barr as General Superintendent of the Chicago, Milwaukee and St. Paul Railway, in place of C. A. Goodnow, who has gone to the Rock Island as General Manager.

Mr. Barr at present is the Mechanical Superintendent of the Erie Railway, but the greater portion of his railroad career was spent in the service of the Milwaukee and St. Paul, where he obtained the reputation as one of the best mechanical experts in the country. He is the inventor of a process of casting car wheels and several devices in use on rolling stock.
