

ROGERS AGAIN TESTIFIES.

Named William Rockefeller as Investor of Gas Funds, It Is Said.

BOSTON, July 6.—H. H. Rogers was a witness again to-day in the hearing before Causten Browne, as master in the suit of Receiver George W. Pepper of the Bay State Gas Company of Delaware against Mr. Rogers and others for \$3,000,000 and interest, alleged to have been illegally secured from the company.

In the course of his testimony Mr. Rogers said that all the investments of the company were made by William Rockefeller. Mr. Rockefeller may be called as a witness.
