

TO ELECTRIFY ROAD.

Chi., Mil. & St. Paul to Spend \$13,000,000 for Puget Sound Extension.

CHICAGO, Nov. 17.—The Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul Railroad will spend \$13,000,000 within the next four years in electrification work in the Rocky Mountain district, it was announced yesterday by C. A. Goodnow, in charge of construction, following the signing of a contract with the General Electric Company, involving a preliminary expenditure of \$2,000,000.

Work will be started immediately in preparation for the electrification of the Puget Sound extension between Avery, Idaho, and Harlowton, Mont., a main line distance of 440 miles
