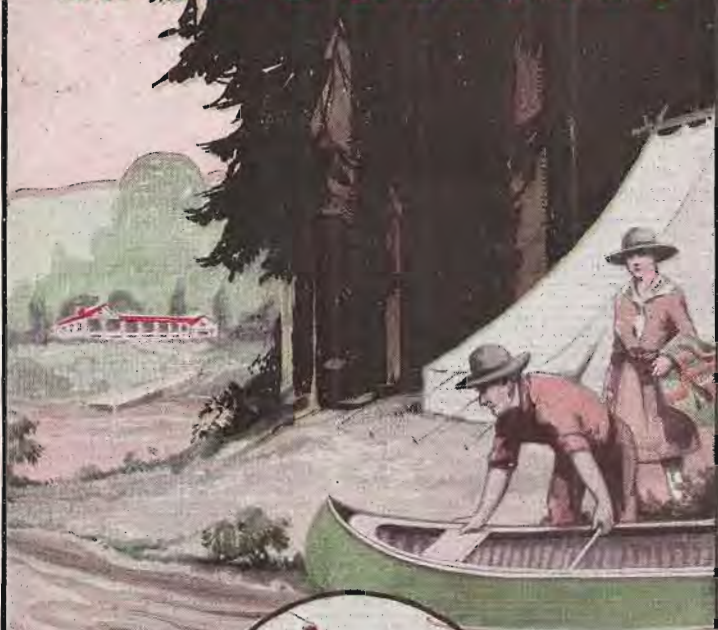

The Wisconsin Conservation Commission through a highly developed system of hatcheries, keeps the fishing grounds constantly stocked with abundant supplies of all the native food fishes.

They carry sleeping cars, coaches, dining cars serving all meals.

The fisherman going up for but a single day of his favorite sport has an opportunity to be on his favorite lake, all breakfasted and ready for the first cast, early in the morning after he has left town. The business-man can lock his desk of a Friday evening, spend a restful week-end with his family at some Northern Wisconsin lake, and be back on the job on Monday morning.

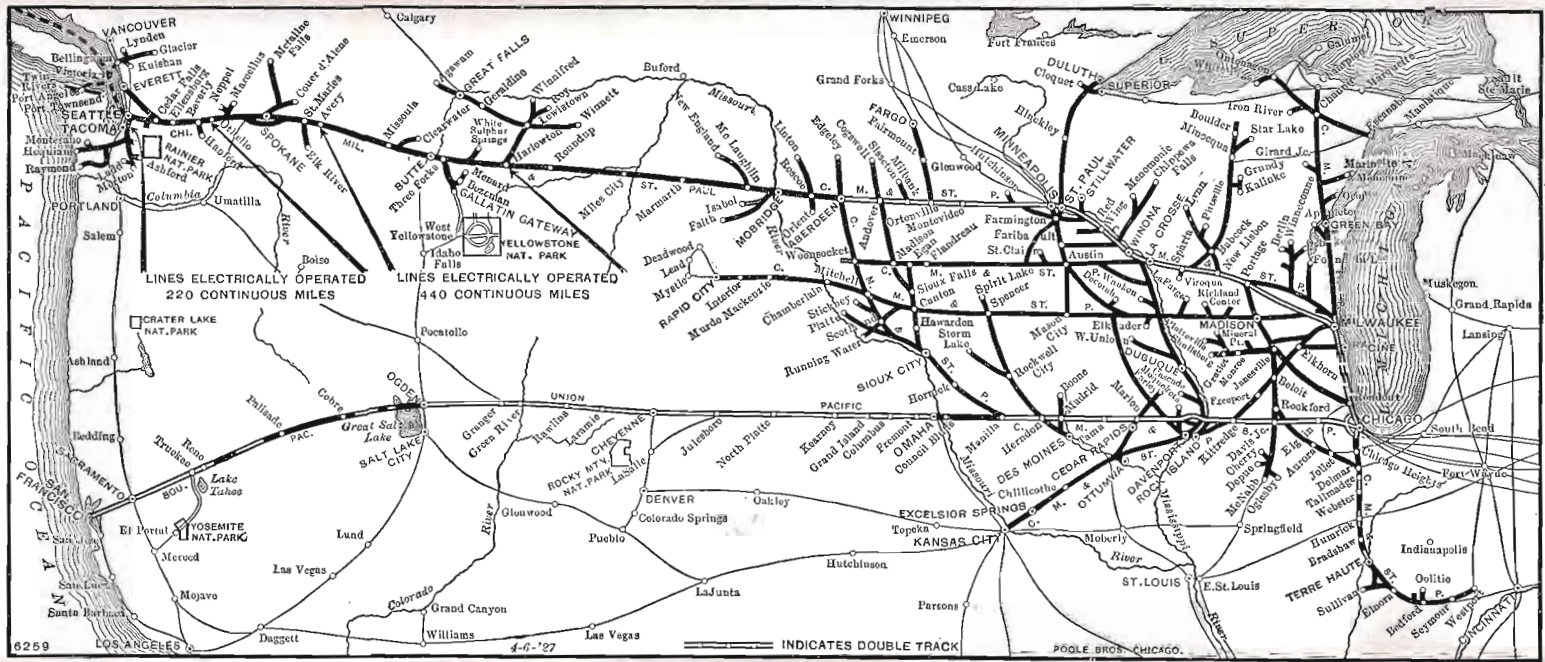

Map of the Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul Railway showing lines under electrical operation

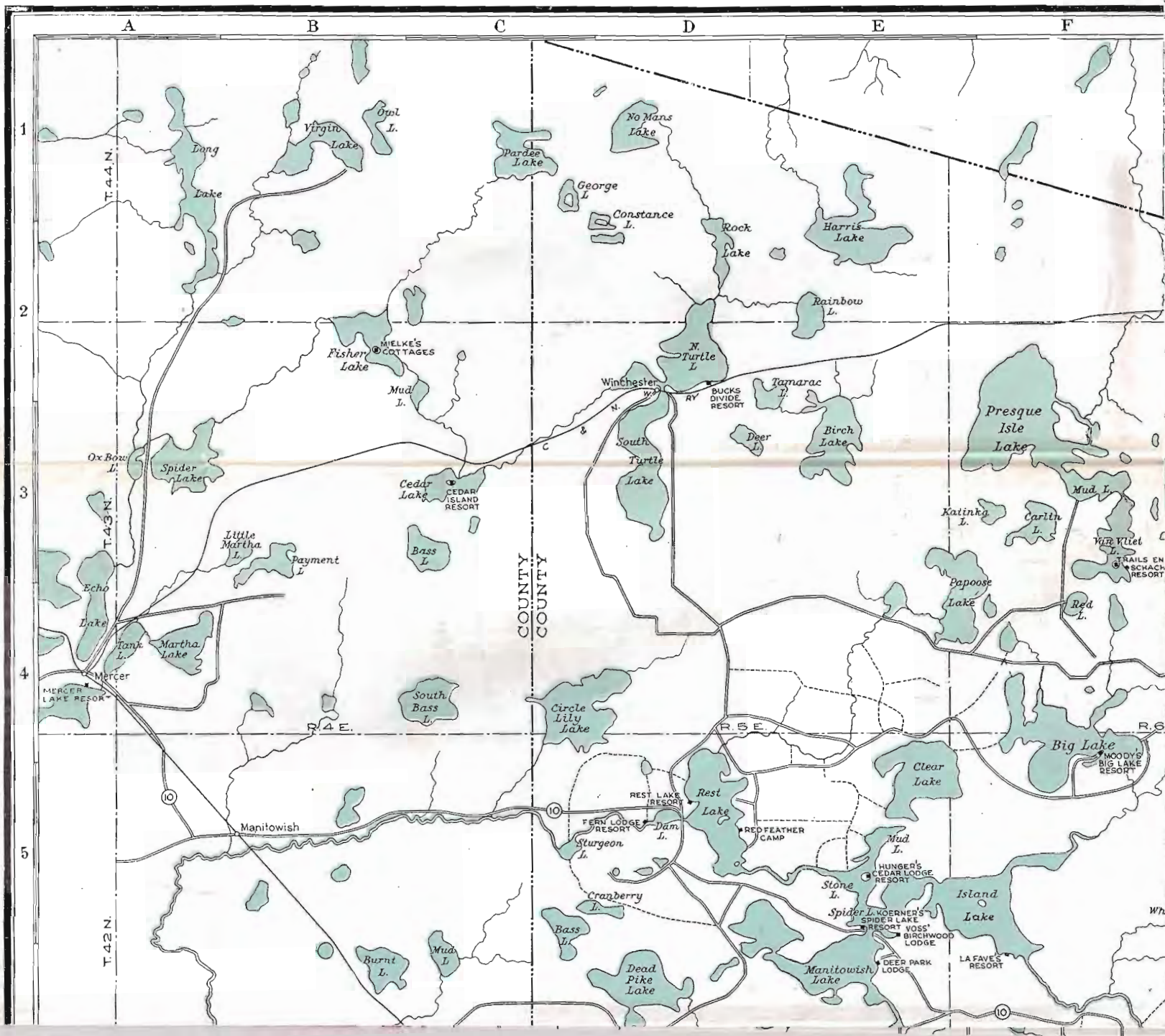


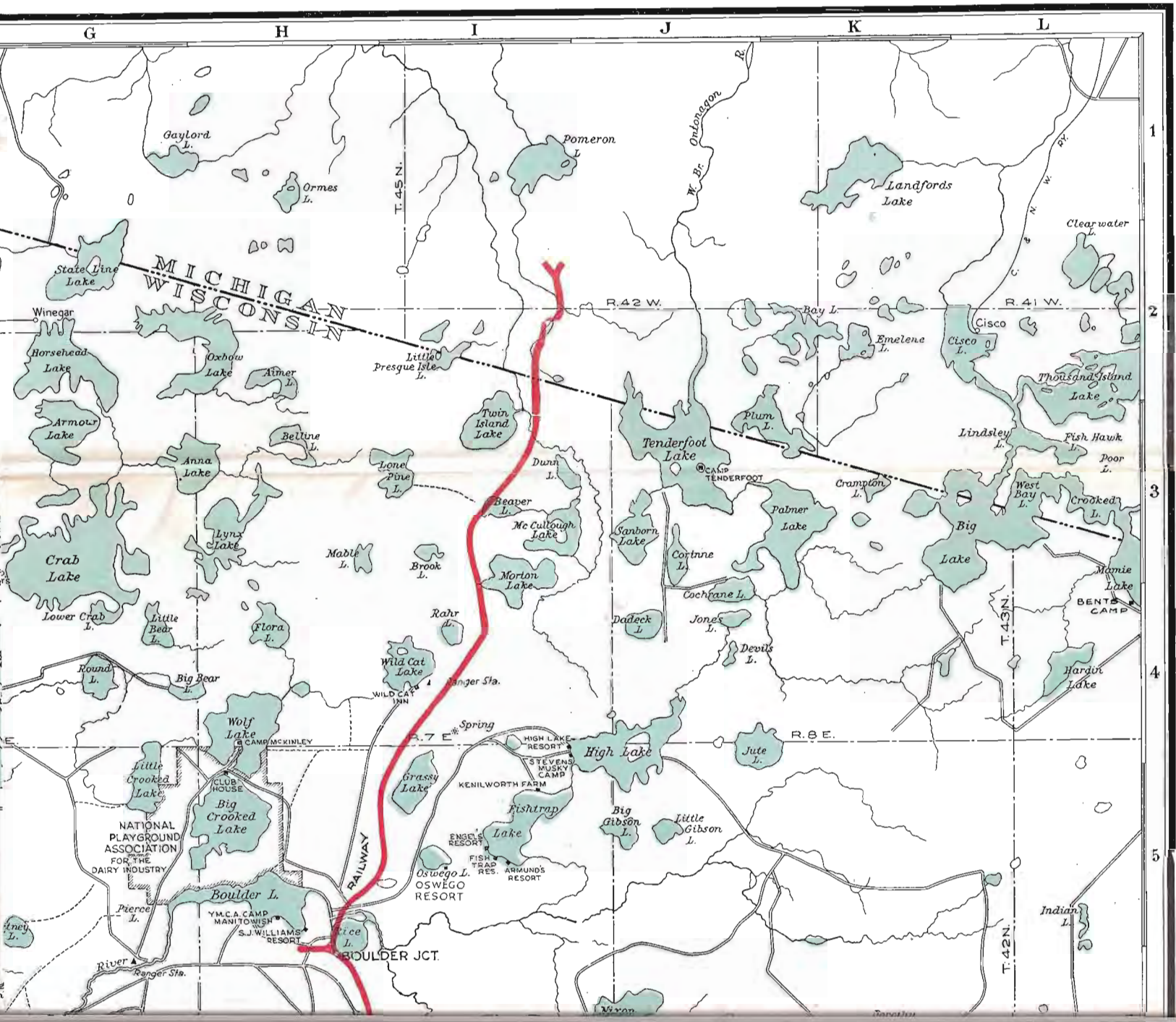

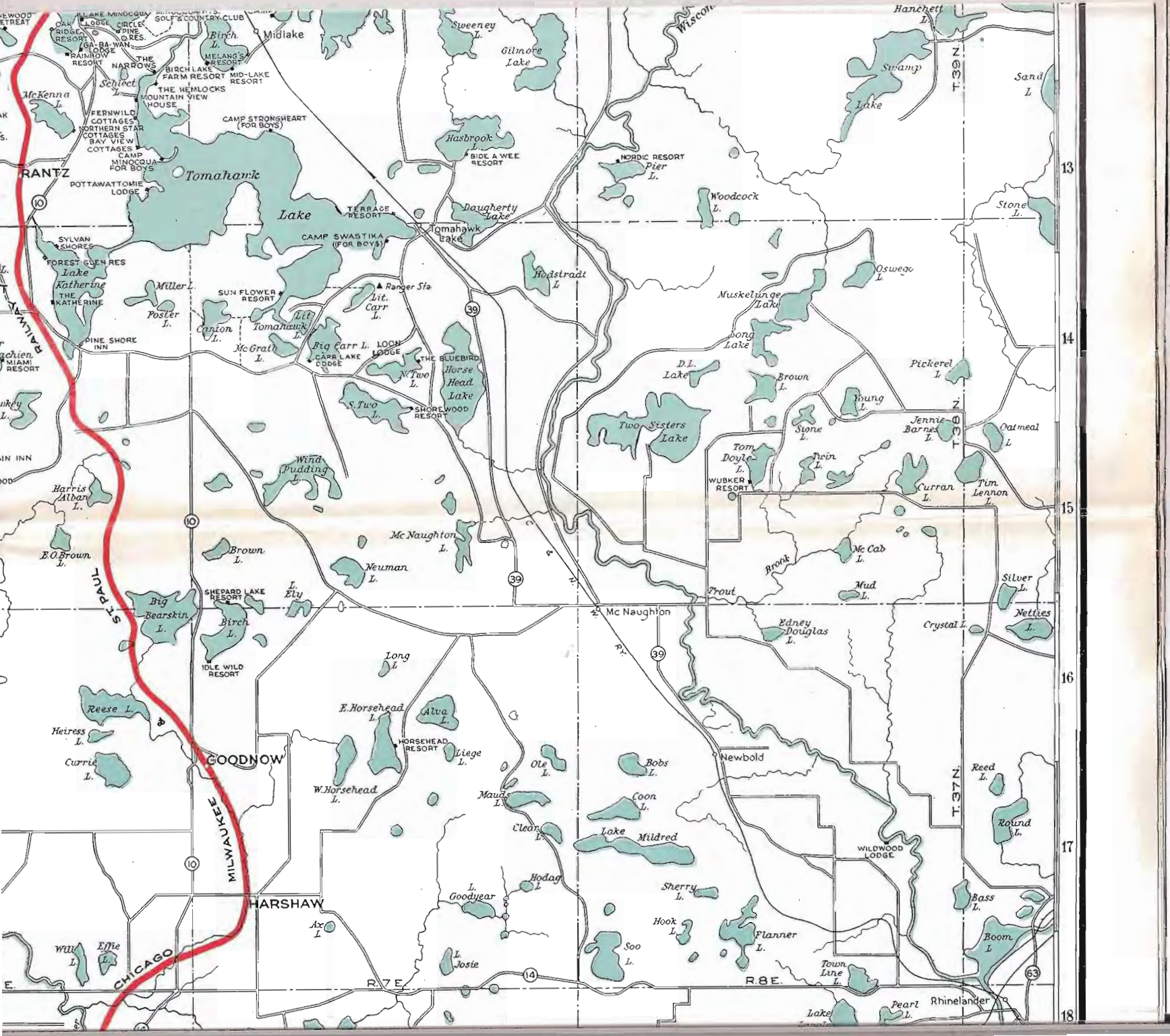
